**IMPORTANT INFORMATION – DRIVER SAFETY EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENT AND
BRANDING FOR RMCGF 2026**

Dear Distributors,

As we experienced several equipment compliance issues during last year RMCGF event, we would like to inform you well in advance and kindly ask you to pass this information on to all drivers that will participate in the ROTAX MAX Challenge Grand Finals 2026, which will take place in Portimão, Portugal, in November 2026.

Please ensure that all drivers carefully verify that their racing equipment fully complies with the RMCGF Sporting and Technical Regulations 2026 before arriving at the event.

DRIVER EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

!!ALL CATEGORIES!!

- Helmets, visors, and racing overalls must have a valid FIA Karting homologation in accordance with Article 7 of the FIA Karting Technical Regulations.
- Boots and gloves must also comply with the requirements of Article 7 of the FIA Karting Technical Regulations.
- Body protection **FIA homologated is mandatory!!**

Micro MAX, Mini MAX and E10 Mini

For drivers competing in the Micro MAX, Mini MAX, and E10 Mini categories, the use of:

- A neck protector is mandatory.
- Body protection **FIA homologated is mandatory !!**

BRANDING & ADVERTISING REQUIREMENTS

Please also ensure that all participants are aware of and comply with the RMCGF Sporting regulations 2026 Article 26 branding and advertising requirements.

Entrants, drivers, mechanics and guests are **not permitted to display or promote brands of companies competing with Rotax, the official chassis partners (Sodikart, Birel ART, Charles Leclerc, Praga and Formula K), or other official partners/event sponsors of the RMCGF 2026, including XPS, MOJO and Bell.**

This prohibition applies, but is not limited to:

- Competition karts
- Kart covers
- Racing overalls and other racing equipment
- Team wear
- Personal clothing and accessories
- Any other equipment, materials or items displaying such competing brands

These restrictions apply throughout the entire period of the competition and in all locations within the event facilities.

Furthermore, it is strictly forbidden to place any advertising, branding, stickers or promotional material on the karts other than those supplied and/or expressly approved by the Organizer/Promoter.

We kindly request that you inform all prospective RMCGF participants from your territory to:

- Review the RMCGF Sporting Regulations 2026 and Technical Regulations 2026.
- Check the validity and homologation status of all racing gear.
- Ensure that all mandatory protective equipment meets the requirements before travelling to Portimão.
- Check all racing equipment, team wear, clothing, kart covers and other materials to ensure compliance with the RMCGF branding requirements.
- Remove any non-permitted advertising or competing-brand identification before arriving at the event.

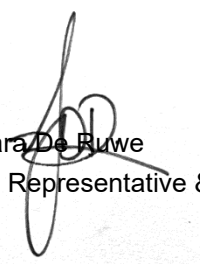
Early verification will help avoid unnecessary issues during scrutineering and throughout the event and will ensure a smooth and successful participation in the RMCGF 2026 in Portimao.
